ATHLETE TRAVEL CONDUCT AGREEMENT

Preamble

Athletes travelling to an event on behalf of the Alberta Racquetball Association represent the Association, their community, the province of Alberta, and the sport of Racquetball. Athletes must understand that travelling is a privilege and should endeavour to represent the ARA with pride, showing respect for themselves and those around them. The Travel Conduct Agreement is designed to clarify what is expected of athletes, confirm the athlete's (or in the case of minors, their parent or guardian's) commitment to these expectations, and to specify consequences in the event that the athlete fails to comply with this agreement.

Agreement

The Athlete hereby agrees:

- To obey the laws of Canada and, if applicable, of the country to which they are travelling;
- To abide by the ARA's Constitution and Bylaws as well as its Code of Conduct and Ethics;
- To not use drugs or medication unless prescribed to them by a registered physician;
- If the athlete is a minor or attending a Junior event, to not purchase, carry, or consume tobacco products or alcoholic beverages;
- To respect the rules and/or curfews set out by any and all Team Alberta Coaches or Chaperones;
- To conduct themselves with appropriate behaviour, including demonstrating a respect for all facilities and event stakeholders;

I, _____, understand that I am travelling as a representative of the Alberta Racquetball Association, and as such my actions and behaviours reflect on the Association, its funding bodies, and the sport of Racquetball. I agree to the terms of this agreement and recognize that it is in effect from the point of departure of my trip until I return home. I understand that failure to comply with the terms of this agreement may result in the loss of funding previously provided to me, the denial of funding not yet received, or other consequences as determined by the ARA's Board of Directors. I also understand that I may be sent home from the event early and at my own expense, at the discretion of any and all Team Alberta Coaches or Chaperones, should my behaviour warrant such action.
